DETAILED SYNOPSIS

Vanessa Chen is Atlanta's top fashion influencer, curated, confident, and captivating. But her seemingly perfect life shatters overnight when a deepfake video surfaces of her making racist remarks, causing her to be "canceled" in real time. Sponsors pull out, fans revolt, and her bank accounts are mysteriously frozen.

As Vanessa races to clear her name, she discovers that the sabotage is far more intimate than corporate rivalry. The betrayal was orchestrated by someone who knows her passwords, every flaw... her sister, Maya.

What follows is a digital cat-and-mouse thriller. Vanessa uncovers a twisted web of AI deception, psychological manipulation, and long-buried family wounds. In a final showdown of hacked feeds and livestreamed truths, Vanessa must reclaim her identity before Maya erases her for good.

Vanessa's fiancé and the con man who began this as a setup but fell in love along the way. Torn between loyalty and survival.

JAYDEN (30s, Any Ethnicity)

A tech investigator hired to help Vanessa, but secretly working for Maya. Represents how easily trust can be manipulated in the digital world.

RIO (30s, Black or Afro-Latina)

A flashy rival influencer and potential red herring. Has her own vendetta against Vanessa, but isn't the mastermind.


