After a devastating digital breakup, dumped for an AI built using her own voice, a brilliant Atlanta software engineer turns heartbreak into revenge by launching Karma, a viral dating accountability app. But when her creation spirals into public chaos, she must confront the difference between healing and harm and open herself to love with the one man who's been quietly writing her story all along.

THE HOOK

A bold, funny, and culturally rich rom-com that turns online revenge culture on its head. This film celebrates Black female brilliance, queer sisterhood, and Southern-fried soul while skewering tech-bro toxicity, viral call-outs, and the illusion of "perfect connection" in the algorithm age.
