LOGLINE

THE PREMISE

The Archive is a slick, emotionally-charged sci-fi thriller that blends cerebral mystery with grounded human stakes. Every citizen's memories are stored, searchable, admissible, and supposedly protected. But as memory manipulation becomes the state's greatest tool, one man risks everything to uncover the truth buried in the collective mind.
