

COLOR PALETTE

- ▶ Neon cyan lighting for tech environments vs. warm tungsten for home spaces
- ► Cold surveillance blues and cyans
- ► Warm domestic oranges and yellows
- ► High contrast between safety and threat

VISUAL MOTIFS

- > Split screens showing dual perspectives (human vs. machine)
- ▶ Compression artifacts and pixelation as narrative devices
- ▶ Reflections in screens and glass surfaces
- ► The recurring timestamp: 3:47 AM

Suburban paranoia where every device feels like a potential betrayer. The aesthetic makes audiences question their own smart homes.


